Space Race is an easy game about self-determination designed for people with developmental disabilities of all ages. The game is fun, it makes you laugh, and it helps you think about what you want to do with your life!

Players begin their mission from the “Launch Pad,” roll the die, and move their game piece forward to make their way back to Earth. Individuals or teams of players read

Game Cards to learn about self-direction and complete “Assignments” to discuss the kind of life they want and the support they need.

To complete their mission, individuals make decisions about home, career, community, health, and social life. Players record their ideas on a “Space Log,” which can later be used to inform transition planning or service planning processes.
